During Jacob's "900 days," you may feel led to write to him by choosing one of those 900 days as a special day for yourself and/or your family. (You are warmly welcome to write to him on other days, too!)

Keep your message positive. Share your experience, strength and hope about a service project you are involved with and say why it has special meaning to you. Receiving mail or books are considered privileges which can be withdrawn. **All means of communication are subject to inspection and restriction.** Avoid partisan political messages. Items that don't conform are returned or discarded.

Here are the basic guidelines to follow to assure your item reaches Jacob and not only supports him through this journey, but also reflects Quaker values that may touch "that of God" in the person who pre-inspects and/or reads what you've sent:

- Use a white envelope
- Your return address must include your full name, handwritten. NO LABELS.
- Use 8½ x 11 white paper; write on one side only
- Don't make the letter too thick! (2-3 pages, no cards or thick fancy paper)
- No staples, no enclosures
- Use a regular blue or black ballpoint pen if you are hand-writing.
